
NEW or GENTLY WORN SNEAKERS being collected during the Ice Cream Social


This study will focus on one of seven phases of spiritual development in our lives.


Shepherd Group 20 A Sunday evening of Faith, Fellowship, Fun & Food


The United Women in Faith have 2 circles:
