### From Pastor Chris

A few thoughts worth sharing with you this week:

First, let me update you on our budget pledging efforts. This report is as of Monday late afternoon. We have received 103 pledges/estimates of giving totaling \$433,293. For the start of our second week of consideration, we feel very good as we look to the ministry opportunities of 2024. If you haven't gotten yours turned in yet, no worries. Drop it by the office anytime! Or, use the convenience of our digital pledge cards by visiting our website and clicking on the "Give" tab along the top menu. Thank you for your support!

Second, a few of you have asked about Disciple Bible Study. It's been five years since our last Disciple 1 class, so perhaps it is time again. Disciple 1 is a 34-week study (17 weeks on the Old Testament and 17 weeks on the New Testament) covering most of the books of the Bible. **Would you like to go through the Bible in 2024?** Perhaps this study is for you! I am assessing interest at this point. 




### Sew for Service November 8 at 1:30pm Activity Room (lower level)
