

ADVENT SEASON

The season of Advent, which comes from the Latin word adventus meaning "coming" or "visit," begins four Sundays before Christmas and ends on Christmas Eve. Advent is the beginning of the church year for Christians. A uniquely joyous and hopeful season in the church liturgical year, our first Sunday of Advent is a little over a week away, being December 3. It is a time for Christians to prepare for the arrival of Christ to the World.

The liturgical color for Advent is **Purple** or **Blue**. Purple, signifying **Penitence and Royalty**. Blue is the color of **Hope**.

Symbols seen during the season of Advent:

Advent Wreath, a sign of life without end.

4 Advent Candles and the Christ Candle (representing light amidst darkness, with the 4 Candles being for Hope, Peace, Joy and Love).

Evergreen Tree and garlands, a sign of ever living, ever green.

Other symbols are Bells, Angels, and Stars.
