

Are you on the call list? Please respond to your caller promptly. If you are not on a call list and plan on attending, please call the Church office at 501-922-1030 to be included in the count.





A group of volunteers is forming now to ensure that we can attend in March of next year on the above date.

The registration fee, lodging, and cost of meals must be sent to Sager Brown the first week of January.

Please prayerfully consider being a volunteer. You will have opportunities to check and assemble hygiene kits, volunteer in the community, or provide maintenance on the Sager Brown campus. An added bonus is meeting other Methodists from across the United States that volunteer on the same week. You will come to realize it is a special place as you go about doing the Lord's work.

The total cost to you is \$330 for the week which includes: 5 nights lodging, 13 meals (Sunday & Wednesday nights we are on our own). The registration fee is \$40 and is non-refundable.
