### Sager-Brown (UMCOR) Team 2024

Sager-Brown Depot in Baldwin, LA. is a supply depot for the United Methodist Committee on Relief. Located on 25 acres, the warehouse used for storage of relief kits and for volunteer workspace, is 46,000 square feet. Each year, more than 2,000 volunteers prepare approximately \$4 million in relief supplies for shipment from the Depot to disasters in the United States. Village UMC has a volunteer team of 7 there as this newsletter is going out. They arrived at Sager-Brown on Sunday, March 10, and will return home tomorrow, March 15. See pictures following this article. Areas they have helped included opening Health Kits, checking their contents for correctness, boxed and crated them. A saying at Sager-Brown "When the world rocks, Sager-Brown Rolls!" Our team has noted that Sager-Brown is a wonderful ministry of the United Methodist church.








PRAYER said as another pallet is made at Sager-Brown.

Traffic will be heavy and lines for local services will be longer.


Do not use cell phone for taking a picture of the Eclipse.
