

From Pastor Chris

This is an historic week as *finally* our denomination is convening the 2020 General Conference in Charlotte, North Carolina. Yes, you read this right! 2020. Thank you, global pandemic ...

The past few years have been significant for the United Methodist Church. Within our Arkansas Annual Conference, we saw 25% of our churches disaffiliate and leave our denomination over theological disagreements regarding a variety of issues. Matters of human sexuality, the 'trust clause' for local church property, power and finances, along with other concerns have created much distraction for a Church called to make disciples for Jesus Christ.

As General Conference - which is the official legislative body for the UMC - meets this week and next, a part of their work will include the 3 R's: regionalization, restrictive language removal, and revised Social Principles. All three are big issues that could have a far-reaching impact in the next season of the United Methodist Church.

You can Google these if you're so inclined, as there's not enough room in this newsletter for me to write on each of these R's. I will attempt next week to offer a synopsis to date and keep you informed as we do remain a part of the UM connection worldwide.

While we celebrate and support our connection of United Methodists from around the globe, our most meaningful ministry will happen right here in our mission field. The work we do as Village UMC, the outreach we share in, the missionaries we support, the ways we serve aid in making disciples of Jesus Christ for the transformation of the world.

Joining me in lifting up our General Conference, and the delegates we have sent from Arkansas, in prayer for God's wisdom and discernment over these next nine days. May God be glorified!




