Ascension Sunday is the 40th day after Easter. It celebrates an important episode in the life of Jesus that the United Methodist Church has regarded highly through the years, His ascension into Heaven where he sits at the right hand of God. (Acts 1:1-11)

PENTECOST - May 19

The 50th day after Easter and the last day of the Easter Season and when the Church received the gifts of the Holy Spirit, It celebrates the descent of the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles and followers of Jesus who assembled in Jerusalem. (Acts 2)

COLOR: Red (Represents Strength and

Fire of the Holy Spirit)

SYMBOLS: Dove, Tongues of Fire


With a Bachelor of Arts Degree in Health Science & Business Economics from Hendrix College Conway, Arkansas
