Faith-Integrated Yoga

Yoga devotion is a wellness practice of breath-centered movement that integrates body, mind, and spirit with faith, to create more space in participants’ lives to experience God’s presence.

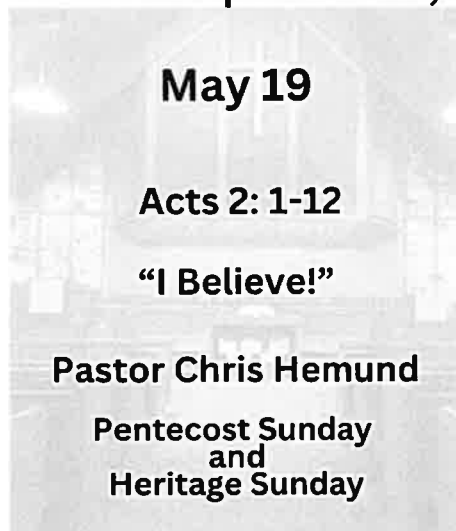
The class is intended for seniors within the congregation and will provide instruction in gentle yoga practices, both seated and standing, that use props such as chairs for support.

Benefits for members of this class will include greater strength, balance, flexibility, and breathing, along with contemplative breath-centered movement to help cultivate deep awareness of God's presence in self and others. Each of the weekly practices is organized into five sections: A Scripture focus reading from sacred text, a spiritual focus from a non-Scripture quotation, a devotion, a breath prayer, and a pose focus to embody the practice theme. The name of the book we will be using is *YogaDevotion: Practicing in the Presence* by Cindy Senarighi and Heidi Green. You do not need the book.

The yoga class is open to all, women and men, and will be offered once a week on Wednesday at 1:30 pm to 2:30 pm in the Searchers Sunday School class for seven weeks. The class will be taught by our member, Pat Sisterhen, who has RYT 200 certification and experience teaching in a yoga studio, YMCA, and another local church.

An informational and interest meeting will be held on Thursday, May 23, at 1:30 pm in the Searchers classroom to inform interested members about faith-integrated yoga and to access interest. Participants can enroll at the interest meeting or at the table in the Narthex.

SYMBOLS: Dove, Tongues of Fire**



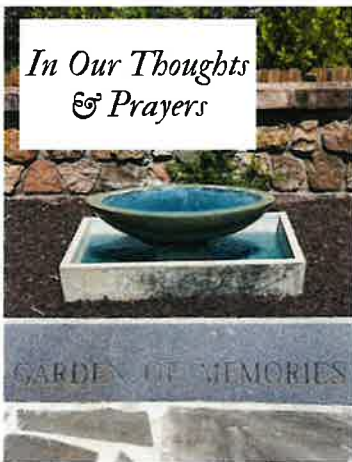

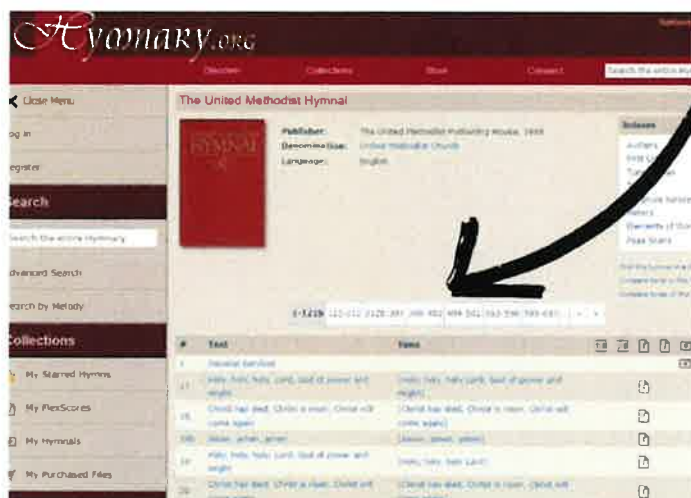
