

Who: Mission u is open to members and non-members of United Women in Faith. Arkansas Conference Mission u offers classes, workshops, mission work, and plenary sessions, as well as studies for children and youth. A nursery is also available for infants and toddlers.

Where: Mission u is held on the Hendrix College campus in Conway.

When: Wednesday, July 17 - Saturday, July 20

Theme: The Kin-dom is among you

Join us at Mission u as we explore what it means to draw doser to God and one another.

Jesus told his followers the kin-dom was among them (Luke 17:21). What does that mean? Who does Jesus say will inherit the kin-dom? How do we transform ourselves and our communities in ways that bring us closer to the kin-dom and the kin-dom closer to us? Cost: \$175 for on campus youth and adults. Other options are available. Scholarships are also available.



As a reminder, ARUMC staff, especially Bishop Merrill, will NEVER ask you to send money or email you for a special favor or request. This is the same as any of the Village UMC staff. Do not interact with these emails.

If you ever receive a questionable email, phone call, or text message that is asking for money, a favor/request, or claiming to have hacked into any of your accounts, please do not click on a link in the message or give any personal information. Please look up the business and contact a secure and legitimate company representative. If you ever have a question about the emails we send, don't hesitate to reach out to us directly.
