I missed you last Sunday, but I joined a good number of folks in the early service from afar. I sure am grateful as always for our Regina Turner and her message, "I Am". Regina serves as our Associate Pastor for Visitation, but as you know, she is a gifted preacher and Bible teacher. She is a blessing for VUMC and to me personally. It is good to be in ministry alongside her.

Also Sunday morning, I joined the livestream service for a sermon preached by a seminary classmate in Richmond, Virginia. Sarah, too, is a gifted preacher, and her message "From Seed to Spirit" was quite inspiring as I reflected upon it this week.

Mission u events also include:






