John 10:7 Therefore Jesus said again, "I tell you the truth, I am the gate for the sheep..."





<u>BUTTON</u> on the keypad just outside the door.


To exit the building, <u>push the GREEN</u> button on the wall to disengage the magnet lock and simply <u>exit</u> as usual.
