John 10:7 Therefore Jesus said again, "I tell you the truth, I am the gate for the sheep..."

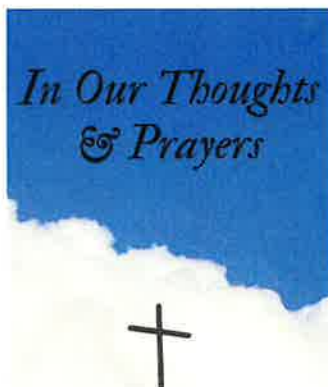

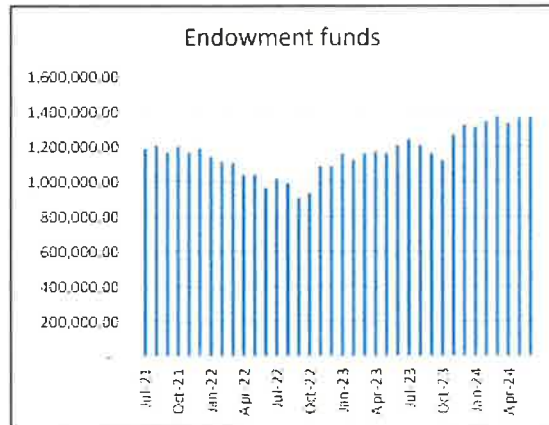
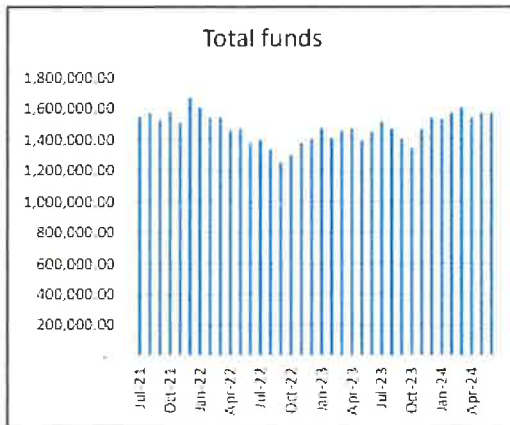
