A Message about our Mobile Food Pantry

It was a busy Tuesday morning downstairs in the Mona Galloway Food Pantry. Gary Mouton and Jay Law transported approximately 2000 lbs. of food from Project Hope to the church to be uncrated, shelved and sacked. This is our monthly order for distribution to the veterans currently being helped in Hot Springs and Pine Bluff as well as the first Saturday distribution to the Mt. Pine area.

Gary and Jay were met at the church by Glenn Wortham, Richard Sanders, Ed Wallace and Trent Cole. These men worked tirelessly, in the heat, to unload the trailer, open the cartons and place them in the pantry where Debbie Perryman, Carolyn Law, Carla Fish, Loraine Melcher, Jean Fleming, and Debbie Mouton meticulously stocked the shelves.

This crew was followed by another group of volunteers who make the food pantry run smoothly by sacking and shelving the bags. Working this week were Slade Strickland, Carla Fish, Pam Van Vickle, DeCarla Hilliard, Marilynn Tanner, Connie Thomason, Elizabeth Strickland and Pat Eubanks. After a productive sacking, Trent Cole and Ed Wallace transported fifty food bags to the Hot Springs Veterans Clinic. There will be another grocery sacking next Tuesday to complete the August 3rd commitment to Mt. Pine. Glenn Wortham and one of our newest volunteers, Scott Luchesi, will make the delivery.

While these are just a few of our volunteers this month, there are many others who, during the year, make it possible for the food pantry to remain viable.

There is a place of service for you! We are especially in need of "man" power. If you are interested in joining us in our endeavor to stamp out food insecurity, please reach out. We do not have a set day of the month. It depends on our availability to pick up the food from Project Hope. The next United Women in Faith meeting will be October 7th as September 2nd is Labor Day and the church is closed. All women are welcome!




We have made it convenient for you! Sign up at church! BUT if you sign up online ... mark your team as Village United Methodist Church.
